

# King Yoga: Cosmic Religion of The Future

Science and Religion

People blame religion for a lot of suffering in the world – especially violence and war. Seldom do we hear the same accusation levelled at science. And yet science is responsible for countless deaths and untold damage to our environment. It is scientists, not priests, who design and produce nuclear bombs, Kalashnikovs; biological weapons etc – all with the specific motive of killing, and, in some cases, the specific motive of the murder of innocent men, women and children.

It is scientists, not monks, who enable us to ravage the planet of its natural resources, with little thought of the long-term consequences. And it is scientists who have invented and created those substances which are now poisoning our air, our soil and our oceans. And yet, science has also done tremendous good, improving living conditions and advancing our culture in numerous ways. This is true, of course. But then again, so has religion. No one can deny that religion has inspired numerous charitable, artistic, musical and philosophical endeavours which, without religion, would never have existed.

The point is simple: it is not religion that is bad, nor is it science that is bad – it is the people who misuse them who are bad. Very bad. Science and religion are the two great facets of the quest for Truth; and yet there are people on Earth who misuse them in ways which are the exact opposite of their positive essence.

### The religion of the future will be a cosmic religion

Speaking of science and religion, one man who had a lot to say about both was Albert Einstein, who famously prophesied: "The religion of the future will be a cosmic religion." By this, he meant that the religion of the future would transcend the myth that our Creator is a personal God a bit like a human being, and that religion would instead be about experiencing oneness with the great cosmic whole.

There is a saying (the source of which is debated) that may sound flippant, but which undoubtedly contains a degree of truth: "God created man in his own image. And man, being a gentleman, returned the favour." The medieval concept of God as a man living on a cloud, with feelings such as anger and jealousy, is entirely man-made. It is, in short, a false idol, worshipped at the expense of a true appreciation of the greatness of what God really is.

What is God? God is all. God is the essence of all life. God, the Absolute, is: "...the beginning – and the end. "And it is the stage before the beginning – and the stage after the end... "...this is – all in all – and all in all – that!"

If there is any truth whatsoever in the idea that God - creator of the universe - really did make us in "his" own image, then I think it means much more than that "we look like God" - something entirely different, in fact. Another great quote attributed to Einstein is as follows: "The most incomprehensible thing about the world is that it is comprehensible." This phenomenon of "comprehensibility" shows that the Creator made us able to understand with our minds, to some extent at least, what his/her/its mind had created. The "image" is not a physical one, but a mental one, albeit on a vastly limited micro-cosmic scale.

### **Christians and aliens**

I would like to suggest that now is the time to take Einstein's idea of a "cosmic religion" a step further. The religion of the future will indeed be cosmic, in the sense of focus on oneness rather than dogma, but that's not all.

It will also have to very seriously incorporate and explain the existence of intelligent extraterrestrial life – and give proper answers as to how we and they fit into "God's plan" for creation. We could pose countless such questions to Christians already: Do aliens have souls? Is Jesus a Divine Saviour to beings on other planets? Do extraterrestrials have heaven and hell? Is it the same as ours? Should 27-legged aliens kneel when they pray? To give them their due, the Vatican has in fact looked at this issue guite seriously – and with a surprisingly open mind. The Vatican's chief astronomer, Rev. Jose Gabriel Funes. has said that to exclude the possibility of life on other planets would be to limit "God's creative freedom". In an interview in the Vatican Newspaper L'Osservatore Romano, headlined 'The extraterrestrial is my brother', Rev. Funes also said that some extraterrestrials might not only be intelligent but possibly more evolved than we are, and have "remained in full friendship with their creator" - even that we might be the "lost sheep" of creation, and that some extraterrestrials might be free from "original sin".

The general spirit of this, I would warmly welcome. But it is still nothing more than conjecture. Pope Francis has said exactly this, when asked about extraterrestrials: "Honestly, I wouldn't know how to answer...". This was the reply of a man who is one of the most prominent religious leaders on Earth! I would like to have asked him why he doesn't know. But he probably wouldn't have known the answer to that either!

Then again, this could, by a conspiracy theorist, be regarded as a rather clever answer, in that he doesn't say that he doesn't know about extraterrestrial life, he just says he wouldn't know how to answer. Personally, however, I do not believe that Pope Francis does have answers. People in the Vatican in the past have known the truth, but that doesn't necessarily mean that he does.

Anyway – in one way it doesn't really matter what they know in the Vatican. The simple fact is that they can't or won't tell anyone else the truth about extraterrestrial life.

#### Aliens and religion: the answers really do exist

However, just because the Vatican isn't telling us anything, doesn't mean the answers don't exist. The answers do exist!

These answers have been revealed by the extraterrestrial visitors themselves,

to a number of "contactees" on Earth. One of the best known and most significant of these was an Englishman named George King (1919-1997), founder of The Aetherius Society.

Fearlessly outspoken and relentlessly controversial, Dr. George King claimed contact with beings from other planets for over 40 years, following his contact with a being known as "Aetherius" in London in 1954. Most of his contacts were through mediumship or telepathy, but he also had a number of "face to face" contacts.

The information given by and through him reveals what extraterrestrials are actually like, and how mankind on Earth can put right the problems we now face as a planetary race.

### **King Yoga**

King Yoga is the spiritual path taught by, and through, Dr. George King.

Yoga is so much more than many people realize. It is indeed an excellent way to keep fit etc – but this is only one tiny aspect of a vast all-inclusive philosophy and a demanding spiritual way of life. The word "yoga" literally means "union", i.e. conscious realization of union with God – the great universal Spirit – which is enlightenment. There are numerous different kinds of yoga, such as hatha yoga, which is, basically, the yoga postures you might do at a typical yoga class. Another kind of yoga is mantra yoga which is chanting sacred sounds. Raja yoga is the yoga of mental and psychic control and development,

through deep-breathing, visualization etc.; and bhakti yoga is the yoga of devotion to a higher power, whether this power be a guru, a Divine being, or God itself. Often the serious student of yoga will practice various different kinds of yoga, each kind complementing the others.

One of the most interesting, and perhaps most underestimated, yogas is karma yoga. This is the yoga of action as taught in the great Bhagavad Gita given by Sri Krishna thousands of years ago. Karma yoga is about performing your duty with detachment from results, dedicating your motivation to God. Another aspect of it is working selflessly to help others. Unfortunately, however, this sometimes seems to be a neglected aspect of this great yoga. This neglect makes no sense because if we look at it literally: it is not possible for us to perform our duty (with or without detachment) unless we devote our lives to helping others as much as we can. Such help could take many forms from charity to spiritual teaching; from medical care to volunteering in the community; from rescuing abandoned animals, to giving spiritual healing; etc.

This selfless service to others is the root of spirituality; nothing else comes close to it in terms of its importance to us as individuals seeking enlightenment, and to us all, globally, in terms of sorting out the world's countless problems.

Our planetary neighbours – who are much more advanced than we are on Earth – have been very clear about the importance of selfless service. This importance is only going to increase as we enter the New Age. Religions without service at their heart will either change or fade away.

The teachings given by Dr. King himself, and through him by those extraterrestrial intelligences who communicated with him, are now, 20 years after his death, referred to as "King Yoga". This consists of three aspects – selfless service to others; spiritual teachings (e.g. revelations about karma and reincarnation); and spiritual practices which lead to selfdevelopment – such as yoga breathing.

Unlike some spiritual teachings – the revelations of King Yoga have not been warped over time; in fact, they have been meticulously recorded and preserved intact. As a result, they are not a hotchpotch of random unexplained rules in which we are meant to have "blind faith", as we find in some religious teaching – they are a logical philosophy that expands the mind and gives us ever-better spiritual vision.

Unlike conventional religion, not only does King Yoga give proper coherent answers to questions about life elsewhere in the universe, but it also offers the spiritual seeker the opportunity to actually work with beings from other planets! Our planetary neighbours can do things we cannot even imagine. The civilizations of Mars, Venus, Saturn etc are so advanced that they do not even exist on this material plane. In other words, they exist at a different frequency, higher than anything that science as we know it can currently detect.

They help us – behind the scenes, as it were – in countless ways, one of which is by radiating spiritual energy. Spiritual energy is a real power – not an airyfairy dreamy thing that doesn't really exist. It is an energy like any other, but much more important, and much less understood, than an energy like electricity, by us on Earth. This energy raises consciousness, if we let it. Using apparatus designed by Dr. King, and by tuning in to this energy, at specific times, we can harness this power and use it to help bring about global healing. You too can get involved in this amazing life-changing, world-changing work – all you have to do, is want to. Personally, I can't understand why the whole world doesn't jump at the chance of doing such an amazing thing!

This cooperation with beings from other worlds is one of the things that makes King Yoga so utterly unique – and distinct from karma yoga in its traditional sense. King Yoga is not meant to replace the great religions of the world – this was not the intention of Dr. King or the intelligences communicating with him. But, it is an opportunity for people of any religion or none to add a cosmic dimension to their understanding, and, even more importantly: a cosmic dimension to their service to others.

Working with the Gods from space is the greatest form of service that anyone can perform. Those of us fortunate enough to be involved in this work are not necessarily great people – in fact we may be very ordinary people – but we have a unique opportunity to work with some of the greatest beings in the Solar System, to help rid our world of war and all the other evils that currently bedevil the human condition.

King Yoga is a way to understand the Gods from space; a way to work with the Gods from space; and ultimately, after many lives, a way to actually become a God in space – with the freedom to roam the galaxy and beyond!
